

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 01 Feb 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A frosty start, then most places will be dry for a time with sunny spells.
However, thicker cloud spreading westwards will bring snow flurries to eastern areas during the afternoon, these becoming heavier during the evening. Feeling very cold in strong and biting easterly winds.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Most places will have periods of snow, these bringing appreciable falls to some areas, particularly over hills in the north and east with drifting in the strong easterly winds. However snow is likely to turn more to rain across southeastern, then central England as slightly less cold air spreads northwestwards.
