

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
An area of very heavy rain will move eastwards across the southern half of Wales and England , eventually clearing southeastern England later this evening. Northwestern Scotland will have gales and driving rain, with snow on higher ground. Otherwise, clear or sunny intervals and scattered heavy showers, mainly in the west.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Sunny intervals and scattered showers on Tuesday, although cloudier with outbreaks of rain across parts of northern England. Wednesday will be a mostly dry day with sunny spells and lighter winds, cloud, rain and very strong winds spreading to northern and western Britain on Thursday.
