Headline:

Rain spreading southeast tonight, clearing eastwards tomorrow, with showers following.

This Evening and Tonight:

Rain extending across rest of England, then clearing from Wales, N.Ireland and southeast Scotland later. Clear spells and showers following, showers mainly in the west.

Wednesday:

Rain will gradually clear eastwards, with showers following. Some showers becoming heavy, prolonged and thundery. Becoming windy in the far west. Feeling cold.

Outlook for Thursday:

Rain spreading across S.Wales and S.England. Generally bright, with coastal showers elsewhere.
