Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a wet start across Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland, this rain should clear most areas by lunchtime but showers and strong winds will follow from the west. Further south it will be largely dry with plenty of sunny spells. Overnight further rain and strong to gale force winds will affect parts of northern England and Scotland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Rain will persist across western and northern parts of Scotland tomorrow but winds will start to ease. Elsewhere will be largely dry, with sunny spells and only isolated showers. Remaining unsettled into Sunday with a band of rain moving eastwards.
