Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Cloudy and dull. Patchy rain, especially over N.England, spreading
across Scotland through the morning then dying away. Mainly dry
elsewhere. However, rain will spread across N.Ireland and W.Scotland
later. Temperatures around normal.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain over SE.England will slowly clear through Thursday morning.
Breezy, showery and feeling cool across Scotland and N.Ireland.
Elsewhere should be fine, dry and rather warm with plenty of sunny
spells. Fine and dry again on Friday with sunny spells across most
parts after a rather chilly, misty start. Some showers may affect
NE.Scotland early on, with rain pushing into the NW, becoming heavier
and more persistent later.
