Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A mixture of sunshine and showers, the showers mainly in the north and west, wintry over higher parts of Scotland but dying down generally during the day. However, rain will spread east to northern and western parts later. Very windy at first, easing later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Showers in the north on Sunday, wintry in places, mainly over hills, along with brisk westerly winds. Rain spreading north and east to many central and southern parts in evening after a generally bright day. This rain will clear Monday morning to leave most parts bright with some sunshine but also wintry showers. Much colder.
