Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally fine with good sunny spells but also some patchy cloud. Clear spells overnight will allow temperatures to drop low enough for a light frost, mainly in rural areas. However it will be cloudier across Devon and Cornwall with the chance of a shower at first. Easterly winds will ease in all but the far south.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A dry start with good sunny spells and the chance of a frost overnight. However it will become rather cloudy in the north and west with a risk of rain from Wednesday afternoon onwards. Also a southeasterly breeze will develop across the UK.
