Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places will start the day rather cloudy with occasional showers. These will be mainly light but some heavy showers are likely in parts of Wales and Southwest England. It should become dry during the afternoon with the cloud breaking to allow sunny spells. However, rain will spread into Southeast England later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will be mainly dry on Saturday with some sunshine. Further south it will be cloudy with outbreaks of mainly light rain. Sunny spells are expected across all parts during Sunday, although a few showers may crop up across Northern Ireland.
