Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain or thundery showers will continue across southwest England, Wales, the Midlands and many parts of northern England. The southeast will be drier, brighter and very warm. Cooler over Scotland and Northern Ireland with scattered showers. Overnight, rain will clear western and central areas, but rain continuing in the southeast and northern England. Showers over Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Most areas will see some sunshine on Wednesday, but with a scattering of heavy showers developing, these showers possibly turning thundery at times. Cloudier over Scotland with rain at times. Another showery day is expected on Thursday with some sunshine.
