

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early cloud and rain will soon clear southeastern England. There'll be sunny spells today, but also scattered showers; these most frequent in the far northwest, with hail and thunder possible. It'll be breezy, especially near heavy showers. This evening, showers will become confined to northern Scotland, leaving a largely dry night with clear spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Bright but chilly to start Friday, with further showers in the far north. It'll turn cloudier for a time away from the far south, but it'll stay mainly dry and bright, and winds will ease. Saturday will be fine with sunny spells, and should feel warmer.
