Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland and Northern Ireland generally dry but chilly with some sunshine, although isolated showers are still possible. Chilly elsewhere with rain affecting most places and turning heavy at times. The best of any dry spells in the far south and far north. Rain becoming confined to the far southeast of the UK overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Mainly dry but chilly with some sunshine on Monday, although scattered showers will develop in places. Further persistent rain will push in from the west during the morning on Tuesday to affect all but the far north of Scotland through the afternoon.
