

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 05 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across central and southern England will become confined to the southeast, clearing by evening. Elsewhere some bright or sunny intervals but also showers, most of the showers in the west and northwest, some heavy. Temperatures mostly near or a little above normal. Tonight, further showers in the west, eastern parts mainly dry.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Showers across northern and western parts will gradually die out, most places becoming dry for a time with sunny spells and winds decreasing. However, further very wet and windy weather will spread from the west overnight, clearing to sunny intervals and squally showers on Thursday.
