

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 06 Dec 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A frosty start then central and southeastern areas sunny. Rain and strengthening winds far northwest spread southeastwards reaching northwest England and northwest Wales later. Southwest turning cloudy with some showers. Rain continues spreading southeastwards tonight, but clear in the southeast at first with an early frost. Clearer weather with blustery, wintry showers follow into northwest England and Wales by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Rain clearing southeastwards early Sunday then brighter and windy with scattered showers, mainly in the north/west. These showers wintry in the north and giving significant accumulations over Scottish mountains. However, they will start to ease later on Monday. Feeling cold.
