

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 13 Sep 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will become patchy across Scotland. Elsewhere areas of mist, low cloud and fog gradually clearing this morning, leaving most places dry with sunny spells and only a few light showers. Overnight the outbreaks of rain will become confined to the far west and north of Scotland, while further rain may just arrive across Northern Ireland. Otherwise dry, patchy fog.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday rain spreading across Northern Ireland, later to southwest Scotland. Meanwhile patchy rain will persist across the north and northwest of Scotland. Elsewhere dry with fog clearing, then sunny spells. Monday rain across Northern Ireland and Scotland, mostly dry elsewhere.
