Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain, or perhaps sleet and snow will clear southern parts of the UK this morning. Apart from a few showers in coastal parts it will be a cold, dry day with sunny periods. Most places should stay dry tonight, and will become cold again, although cloud and outbreaks of rain will spread into the southwest by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Dry and bright in the east, but rain and freshening winds will spread across western then central areas, with snow possible, mainly in the north. Rain should clear on Monday it will stay windy with showers, especially in the west.
