Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A dry and largely sunny day for much of England and Wales, and together with light winds it will feel warm in the sunshine. However, for Northern England, Scotland and Northern Ireland, it will be cooler, cloudier and breezier, with spells of rain likely for northern and western Scotland throughout the day.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

On Sunday, rain should move southwards and ease to showers over Scotland, with some possibly turning wintry over higher ground. Isolated showers are expected for many places on Monday; staying driest in the southeast. It will fall cold overnight, with patchy frosts, and winds strengthening across Scotland later.
