Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Some blustery sleet or snow showers are likely over eastern parts, with isolated showers perhaps developing elsewhere during the day. Otherwise a generally dry, sunny and rather cold day is expected with moderate northerly winds. Northwest Scotland will become cloudy with some rain later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Becoming cloudy from the west during Wednesday, with some rain across Scotland, and some light drizzle elsewhere, especially in the west. Thursday will be largely dry but rather cloudy over England and Wales, whilst elsewhere will see some rain pushing east with showers following. That rain will reach the south overnight. Temperatures will be around normal.
