Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud will increase across northern areas today, with some rain and drizzle, mainly across northwest Scotland. Elsewhere will be largely dry with plenty of sunny spells after a cool start. Cloud will gradually southeastwards overnight and some light rain will affect northwestern parts. Breezy in the north, and chilly in the southeast especially this evening.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Mostly cloudy on Wednesday with occasional outbreaks of light rain, mainly in the north and west, sunniest in the south and east. Breezy, windy in the north. Windy and rather cloudy with showers or spells of rain on Thursday. Severe gales likely over northeast Scotland.
