Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be fine today with sunny breaks in the south. Cloudy conditions will prevail in the north, however, with drizzly rain in western parts over the high ground, particularly in western Scotland. Temperatures will be mild throughout. Breezy in the north with a brisk westerly, but light winds over southern parts.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Mostly dry again Monday, although cloudier, with morning fog and mist patches. Some rain or drizzle in the west, increasing over the northwest later. Rain gradually spreading to all but the far southeast on Tuesday, with cooler more showery conditions to follow later.
