

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Persistent rain will affect central and northern parts of the UK, with snow over Scotland falling mainly on hills. Meanwhile, staying drier and milder further south, but very windy and remaining fairly cloudy with light drizzle at times. Gales are likely in places later in the day. Overnight, similar conditions are expected to prevail across the country.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Winds will ease this weekend, with persistent rain becoming slow-moving over central Britain, especially Wales. To the north of this, it will be cooler with sunshine and wintry showers. To the south, milder, but remaining fairly cloudy and windy with occasional light rain.
