

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 06 May 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mainly dry and bright across southeastern England, Scotland and Northern Ireland, but cloudier elsewhere with occasional rain or showers. Showers may be locally heavy and thundery across south Wales and southwest England. Overnight, it should be largely dry with only isolated showers across far southwestern parts, and occasional rain for northeast England and Scotland. Feeling chilly despite light northeasterly winds.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A mixture of sunshine and showers on Friday, with the brightest weather across northeastern parts of the UK. Occasional rain is expected for England and Wales on Saturday, with brighter conditions across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Northeasterly winds will strengthen.
