Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southeast England and northern Scotland will be cloudy with patchy rain and some fog today. Elsewhere it will be mostly dry with bright spells, especially across southern Scotland, northern and western parts of England, and west Wales. The southeast and northwest of Britain will have further patchy rain overnight. Clear spells will develop elsewhere. Local frost and fog.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Most areas will be dry with light winds on Easter Sunday. It will feel warm where the sun appears. However, southeast England and northwest Scotland could catch a shower. Easter Monday will also be largely dry and settled. Patchy frost and fog.
