Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A showery band of rain moves southeastwards into England and Wales during the day, however southeast England should remain fine and dry. Meanwhile, windy with sunshine and blustery showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland. Most places will become dry overnight with clear spells, but still breezy towards Scotland with showers continuing in the west.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, wet and windy weather over Northern Ireland will spread to other western parts by evening. Ahead of the rain it will be largely dry and bright, but turning windy. Breezy on Sunday with sunshine and scattered showers, most of these across northern Britain.
