Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Rain will continue to spread south through the day, turning to sleet and snow over the hills across northern England and Wales. Brighter weather will spread into northern parts of the UK, however this will be accompanied by scattered snow showers. Feeling cold for many, with increasing northeasterly winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Very cold on Wednesday, with rain, sleet and snow accompanied by strong winds for much of England and Wales. Elsewhere will be mainly dry with some sunny spells. Rain, sleet and snow becoming restricted to the southeast of the UK by Thursday with most places remaining cold with sunny spells.
