

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 09 Jul 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wet across Wales and Central and Southern England with periods of heavy rain. Further north it will be brighter but with the risk of some showers. The rain will spread into Northern England, Northern Ireland and Southern Scotland this evening, but will die out further south overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

The south of Scotland will have a wet day with periods of heavy rain, although the rain should become lighter later. Elsewhere, after a wet start in Northern England, there will be sunshine and occasional showers. These could be heavy in places but the southeast could well stay dry.
