Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
After a frosty start in the far south, cloud and rain, preceded by a little sleet or snow, will spread from the north. The cloud and outbreaks of rain will then linger over Northern Ireland, England and Wales, turning to sleet or snow in some northern areas later. Temperatures will be close to, or a little above normal. Scotland, after a dull, wet start in southern parts, will turn brighter as strengthening northerly winds bring colder weather with sunshine and wintry showers.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Sunny spells, but cold and windy with snow showers in many areas and widespread frost overnight.
