Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Saturday will be dry and fine with lengthy sunny spells for most, however the far north of Scotland will be cloudier with occasional rain and a little hill snow. Winds will be lighter compared to recent days, giving a less cold feel than of late.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Sunday should again be largely fine and dry, although perhaps cloudier than Saturday, with rain perhaps reaching the far southwest later. It should turn wetter but less cold across the south of the UK on Monday, while northern parts should stay drier but colder with a few wintry showers.
