Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Thundery rain across many southern and western parts of England should gradually weaken and die out, then most places will have some spells of warm and humid sunshine. However, further thundery showers are expected to break out as temperatures rise, especially across eastern England where some will bring torrential downpours, perhaps with hail and gusty winds. Western areas will turn more generally cloudy later with some mostly light rain or drizzle and here it will feel cooler and fresher by evening.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most places should have some sunny intervals and also a few showers. Later on Saturday, heavy rain and strong winds will spread to many places. It will feel much cooler and fresher than recently.
