Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Mostly dry with light winds and some sunny spells. Feeling pleasantly warm in that sunshine. However, some heavy showers will affect southern England and possibly south Wales, dying out this evening. Otherwise dry with light winds tonight with some mist and fog patches. Rain over the Western Isles later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain, then showers, and breezy southwesterly winds spreading across Scotland and N.Ireland on Tuesday. Dry with sunny spells and light winds elsewhere.

Showery rain will push across England and Wales on Wednesday. Otherwise, sunny spells and showers, locally heavy. Rather breezy at times. Temperatures around normal, locally warm in any sunshine.
