

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Saturday 07 Feb 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Variable amounts of cloud and some sunny spells, the best of which will be in the east. However, occasional drizzly outbreaks of rain will affect northwest Scotland. Temperatures will be suppressed where any fog lingers, but locally mild in the northeast.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Largely dry, but often cloudy for many, on Monday and Tuesday. The best of the sunny breaks will be across eastern parts. However, patchy drizzle may affect northwestern parts at times. It will remain rather cold in the south, but nearer normal, or locally mild, further north. Frost and fog patches will develop by night where skies clear.
