




Yellow warning
Thunderstorm

18:00 Wed 16 Jun 2021 and
21:00 Thu 17 Jun 2021



Whilst most places staying cloudy with little rain there is a chance of a few thunderstorms developing Thursday afternoon.

What to expect

- There is a small chance that homes and businesses could be flooded quickly, with damage to some buildings from floodwater, lightning strikes, hail and strong winds
- Where flooding or lightning strikes occur, there is a chance of delays and some cancellations to train and bus services
- Spray and sudden flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- There is a small chance that some communities become cut off by flooded roads
- There is a slight chance that power cuts could occur and other services to some homes and businesses could be lost


Further details

Whilst for most overnight rainfall will gradually fade leaving a mostly cloudy picture during Thursday afternoon there is a chance that thunderstorms may develop. This is most likely over parts of East Anglia and southeast England though still only a small chance.

Where these do occur torrential rain, frequent lightning, hail and strong gusty winds are possible. Rainfall totals of 20 to 30 mm could fall in an hour, with a few locations perhaps receiving around 50 mm in two or three hours.

Reason for update

The warning area has been trimmed to where thunderstorms may develop Thursday afternoon. If these do occur they may last into the evening and so the end time has been extended slightly
