

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Breezy with showers over Northern Ireland and Scotland, some heavy. Drier and brighter for England and Wales, with just isolated light showers, mainly in the west. Becoming mainly dry and clear overnight, but with wind and rain arriving in Northern Ireland and western Scotland by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Wet and very windy on Sunday across Northern Ireland, Scotland and northwest England, with a risk of severe gales across Scotland. Rain then spreading further south and east during the afternoon, weakening as it does. Monday should be drier and brighter for most, although showers are likely again in northwestern parts of the UK.
