Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be another dry day with some fairly warm sunshine for most. However, cloud will increase across parts of southern Britain, and there may be a little rain in the far north. It will stay dry this evening and overnight, with clear skies across much of central Britain where it will be chilly again.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Most places will be fine and warm but the far north of Scotland will be cloudy with patchy rain. Thunderstorms may affect the extreme southwest of England on Thursday, with spells of heavy rain and thunder expected to spread northeastwards during Friday.
