Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of the UK will be dry with sunny spells and light winds but showers are expected in the east and southeast of England. It will become cloudy across Scotland and Northern Ireland with occasional rain. Little change is expected overnight but it will be cold for most where cloud breaks, with patchy frost and fog forming.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Most places will stay dry with sunny spells over the weekend. Isolated showers will continue in eastern and southeastern England, and the far north of Britain will be cloudier with rain at times. Low overnight temperatures will give frost and fog in places.
