Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain clearing northeast Scotland first thing, but not Shetland until afternoon. Otherwise, all areas will have sunshine and blustery showers, some of these rather heavy with a risk of thunder, especially over hills in the north & west. Feeling rather cool at times in brisk southwesterly winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Heavy rain & strong winds will spread northeastwards early on Wednesday, clearing away to leave a windy afternoon with plenty of sunshine and just a few showers. A chilly night to follow, then more rain, perhaps prolonged and heavy will spread eastwards to all areas on Thursday. Feeling rather cool at times.
