Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Scattered showers are likely to affect most places, with western parts of Wales and perhaps the far southeast of England staying the driest and brightest. It will be another chilly day for many, although it should feel pleasant in any sunshine, especially with only light north to northeasterly winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Showers or longer spells of rain are expected across Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales, northwest and southwest England, but it should be drier and brighter elsewhere with only isolated showers. Temperatures will remain below normal, falling quite cold overnight, and winds should continue to be mainly light.
