Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Heavy rain at first over N.Ireland will gradually clear with a brighter
afternoon to follow. The rain will linger over much of Scotland away from the
northwest all day and this showery rain will spread to western fringes of
England and Wales later, but for much of the rest of the country will be dry,
fine and very warm.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

E.Scotland and parts of NE.England could stay wet for a while on Monday, but
elsewhere will see a mixture of sunshine and showers on both days, and some of
these are likely to be heavy and thundery. Temperatures nearer to normal.
