Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Drizzly rain in the north will edge southwards, this mostly dying out, but a little will remain across some central areas by evening. Brighter, fresher weather will follow from the north, with some sunshine, but also one or two showers. In the south, it will be mostly cloudy, but some sunshine is likely in places and where the sun shines, it will turn out pleasantly warm. Tonight, it will remain cloudy in the south and southwest with patchy drizzle. Elsewhere, clear spells and patchy mist, and cooler than recently.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

After a quiet day Wednesday with some sunshine in the north and east, rain will spread east to most places on Thursday followed from the west by some sunshine.
