Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
A band of occasionally heavy rain will cross most parts during Tuesday as rain extends to the southeast. Becoming drier as much brighter weather with a scattering of showers follows across Northern Ireland, Scotland, Wales, and central and western parts of England. many western areas will have some good sunny spells developing.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Becoming mainly dry on Wednesday with some rain across northwestern Scotland and Northern Ireland. Feeling warm in the brighter spots in the south. On Thursday southern areas will be dry with some pleasantly warm sunny spells, but with patchy rain extending to northern England, Northern Ireland and Scotland.
