Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places will be dry with some pleasant spells of autumn sunshine, and the winds will be light. Scotland will have patchy rain but this will clear and brighter spells are likely for the afternoon. Tonight will be dry with clear spells and isolated fog patches, but the northwest of Scotland will become windy with light rain.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Wet and windy in the far northwest of Scotland on Friday, and the rain will move south towards Northern Ireland on Saturday. England and Wales will be dry on both days with clear or sunny spells after the clearance of overnight fog patches.
