


Heavy rain causing flooding and disruption.

What to expect

- Homes and businesses are likely to be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Fast flowing or deep floodwater is likely, causing danger to life
- Delays and some cancellations to train and bus services are likely
- Spray and flooding probably leading to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- A good chance some communities cut off by flooded roads
- Power cuts and loss of other services to some homes and businesses likely

Further details

Persistent, heavy rain will affect the area during Thursday and much of Thursday night, before slowly dying out on Friday morning. 30 to 40 mm has already fallen across a wide area, with a further 20 to 40 mm expected over the next 12 hours or so. There remains potential for totals of 100 mm over high ground by tomorrow morning.
