Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many places starting cloudy with a few showers around, the heaviest of these confined to the far southwest. It will become brighter and drier from the north through the day, with most areas seeing some extended sunny spells by evening. Thicker cloud will spread into eastern England after lunch, with rain likely in East Anglia by late afternoon.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain and drizzle will spread to most parts of England and Wales on Saturday, but should move away to the south on Sunday morning, giving most places a dry afternoon. Scotland and Northern Ireland staying dry with sunny intervals on both days.
