



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Colder air is now being drawn westwards and southwards across southern parts of the UK. Where surfaces will have been left wet following yesterday's mix of rain, sleet and snow, there is an enhanced risk of icy stretches developing on untreated surfaces as temperatures fall close to or below zero from the north.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **15:00 on Sat, 12th Jan 2013** until **11:00 on Sun, 13th Jan 2013**

Following the mixture of rain, sleet and snow late yesterday, there is a risk of icy stretches on untreated surfaces across the southern half of Wales and much of southern England, more particularly away from the immediate south coastal strip.

The public should be aware of the risk of disruption to travel.
