

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It should be dry and fine for many with the best of the sunshine over parts of northwestern Scotland, Wales, central and southeastern England. However, a band of rain will move across southwestern parts followed by heavy showers later. Rain and showers will edge slowly northwards overnight but many central and northern areas will be dry and chilly.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

The southern half of the UK will remain changeable with bright or sunny intervals and further showers, some heavy and thundery. Many northern and western areas will be mostly dry with sunny spells and an isolated shower. Temperatures will be around normal.
