Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Southern/southwestern parts of England/Wales dry with sunny spells.  
Remaining parts of England/Wales, more cloud than of late, but most  
places seeing some decent sunshine. Mostly dry, although the odd  
light shower is possible. Scotland/N.Ireland rather cloudy, the odd  
shower developing. Some brighter spells likely in sheltered  
southeastern parts. Patchy rain/drizzle affecting N.Scotland.  
Temperatures, generally a little above normal, warm in the sunnier  
south/southwest.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A good deal of dry weather, and although rather cloudy at times,  
there will also be some bright or sunny spells. Temperatures near or  
a little below normal, but still warm in the brighter spots.
