Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Exceptional, damaging winds are expected in Scotland this afternoon and evening, with winds reaching over 80 mph at times. It will also be very very wet, with snow on hills. The rest of the UK will also be windy with band of heavy squally rain moving southwards through the day. Dry, clear weather is following the rain.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cold but sunny for many on Friday, but wintry showers in northern England and the Midlands. Saturday will be a fine and bright day with light winds and only scattered wintry showers in northern parts of Britain. Feeling cold once again.
