

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 09 Dec 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy, with showers or rain in most parts, locally heavy with some hail and thunder. However, there will also be some drier, brighter interludes. Gales in the south, with severe gales in the southwest, especially over Cornwall. Showers will persist over central and eastern England overnight, whilst elsewhere will become dry, but rather chilly.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Cloud and outbreaks of showery rain over central and eastern England will gradually ease away eastwards during Monday, whilst elsewhere will be mostly dry with plenty of sunshine. Winds will ease through the day. Mostly fine on Tuesday, but rain will reach western parts later.
