

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 07 Aug 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud and patchy rain will spread east across south Wales and southern England, becoming locally heavy in the west. Scattered showers elsewhere, although it should become mainly dry with bright spells in northwest Britain and the Midlands. Becoming dry for most overnight with some fog patches, although it will remain cloudy across the south, with outbreaks of rain.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Any remaining cloud and rain will disperse on Wednesday, leaving a generally dry and bright few days. It will feel warm, particularly in sunshine across the south, but also quite humid. Mist and fog may affect some coasts, particularly in the south.
