Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very cold, with snow showers continuing across northeastern England and eastern Scotland. A few snow showers possible over the far west of Wales and southwest England, with more frequent showers for eastern England. Dry with plenty of sunshine elsewhere. Very cold overnight with frost and ice, and snow showers becoming mostly confined to southern and eastern parts of the UK.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A cold, bright and sunny start for many with further snow showers spreading from the east and affecting many parts through the day. Drier on Saturday with snow spreading from the southeast in the evening. Winds strengthening from the east.
