

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showery rain in the southeast, locally heavy with thunder, will gradually clear. Scattered blustery showers for northern and western areas with a hail and thunder risk. Much of central and eastern England will be mainly dry with some sunshine. A cold, mainly dry night with frost likely in northern areas. Winds will ease with showers persisting across many coastal areas.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

A cold start with scattered showers Tuesday, mainly around coasts but likely to also develop inland through the afternoon. Winds increasing in the west, gales possible in the north. Blustery showers dying out from the northwest Wednesday with winds easing.
